MSHC Guidelines on Good Practice for Coaches, Umpires and Volunteers:

- Put the welfare of the child first – before winning or achieving goals.
- Treat all young players equally, with respect and dignity.
- Build a balanced relationship to empower the players to share in the decision making process.
- Make hockey fun and enjoyable and promote fair play.
- Keep coaching skills, qualifications and insurance up to date.
- Get to know the young players and their parents/ carers.
- Be an excellent role model.
- Give enthusiastic and constructive feedback rather than negative criticism.
- Recognise the development needs and capacity of young players.
